HANDLING INSTRUCTIONS (OPTIONAL)

- **HXA** (Followed by number). Collect landline delivery authorized by addressee within Miles.
- HXB (Followed by number). Cancel message if not delivered within hours of filing time.
- **HXC** Report date and time of delivery (TOD) to originating station.
- **HXD** Report to originating station the identity of station from which received, plus date and time.
- **HXE** Delivering station get reply from addressee, originate message back.
- **HXF** (Followed by number). Hold delivery until (date).
- **HXG** Delivery by mail or landline toll call not required. If toll or other expense involved, cancel.
